### GO FAQ

1. **Should students qualifying for alternate assessments participate in the GO strategies?** Yes, with the accommodations specified for those students.
2. **How can I, as a teacher with limited reading opportunities, incorporate GOs into my lessons?** You are encouraged to use the resources provided such as the information from the in-services with the Lincoln Northeast teachers, Sue Pressler, and GO websites that have been shared.
3. **Is a note taking outline a Graphic Organizer?** No. Software will be available soon that will transfer GOs to an outline format and vice versa.
4. **Are GOs to be given prior to instruction?** No. It is encouraged the GO should be modeled and have guided practice with the teacher before they are completed independently. After the students understand how they work, they can be used before, during and after instruction.
5. **Could/should I develop a test to use next year at the same time in my curriculum?** No. This would take away from the random nature of the L to J process. This would prohibit the revision of the vocabulary list.
6. **Do I save all of the GOs my students have been completing?** No, you don't have to keep all of the GOs. You may want to return them to the students as a study tool. You may want to make copies of several types of GOs for examples in future years.
