- SITES: FAIRBURY HIGH SCHOOL – 1501 9TH ST. The team busses can pull into the circle drive and drop off the student-athletes. We will have a person greet the team as they enter through the main doors of the building. Busses will then be able to park in the gravel parking lot located directly south of the school building.
- '47 GYM LOCATION – Located at 703 K Street – Parking will be a little tougher for busses at this facility. The best opportunity would be to park on the South side of the facility. Teams will be able to enter the facility by using the main entrance on the East side of the building. We will have a person greet the team as they enter the building. There is no air conditioning in this facility so please plan accordingly.
- ENTRIES & ROSTERS: All team rosters are due on **WEDNESDAY, Sept. 16, 2020**. Please email a copy of your team roster to Sandy Reikofski at sreikofski@fairburyjeffs.org.
- ENTRY FEE: \$120 per team (please pay as soon as possible)
- LOCKER ROOM ASSIGNMENTS: We have two locker rooms available at the high school and two locker rooms available at the '47 gym. Each team will be directed to their locker room upon arrival. We anticipate no problems with security for the locker rooms, as they are located just off the gymnasium. However, please collect all valuables, as Fairbury Jr-Sr High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Obviously with 6 teams and four locker rooms we will have to share a locker room at one time or another but we do our best to assign locker rooms to limit the possibility of any conflicts.
- WARM-UP: Games 1 and 2 will have a full 16 minute warm-up. All subsequent games will utilize the 11minute warm-up.
- WARM-UP BALLS: Warm-up balls will be provided at each site. **With the New Covid Procedures, Please bring your own Volleyballs for Warm-ups**
- ADMISSION: Admission prices: ADULTS: \$6.00
STUDENTS: \$4.00
Sorry, no passes will be accepted for the tournament.
- TEAM PASSES: Any member of the team, manager, coaches, bus drivers and administration will be admitted free. Please have all members with the team get a stamp when they arrive at the initial site.
- SPIRIT LINES: Due to the chance of injury to spectators and/or student-athletes spirit lines are not allowed on the game floor.

BUILDING

ENTRANCE: Spectator parking lot is located to the South, Southwest, and West of the high school facility. A majority of the parking lot is paved with another part having gravel. The building entrance will be easily seen on the Southwest side of the facility. The '47 gym location has limited parking around the facility. Some may have to utilize street parking.

2020 NSAA Volleyball COVID-19 Modifications

NSAA Approved Rulings:

1. Extend the deadline to submit varsity schedules to the NSAA from August 21st to August 27th.
2. Matches canceled due to COVID-19 will be considered a “no contest.”
 - a. Wild card points will not be awarded for “no contest” matches.
 - b. Forfeits will not be issued for “no contest” matches.
3. Replacement matches (not originally scheduled) may be scheduled at any time.
 - a. Wild card points will not be awarded.
 - b. Contest limits/competition points may not be exceeded.

NFHS Match Protocols:

1. Face coverings are permissible for athletes, coaches, officials, game administration, and spectators.
2. Officials are permitted to use electronic whistles.
3. Score table is limited to essential personnel only.
 - a. Scorekeeper, clock operator, libero tracker, announcer if using
 - b. Maintain social distancing
4. Pre-match and post-match handshake protocols are prohibited.
5. Not switching team benches/courts between sets is permissible.
