Entering the Facility:

Falls City & Auburn Fans will be seated on the South side of the gym.

Players and Coaches Passes:

Each school will be allowed 24 passes for coaches, players and student managers. Please send your list using the form attached at your earliest convenience.

Administrative Passes:

Each school will be allowed 6 administrative passes for supervisory personnel. Please add these names to the bottom of the team pass list and they will be admitted free of charge.

Band and Cheerleaders Admission:

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, no band will be allowed. Each team will be allowed to bring 6 cheerleaders and 1 sponsor. Please send your list using the form attached at your earliest convenience. These 7 individuals will be required to pay regular admission. They are only added to the list due to the limited admission.

Fan Attendance:

Due to DHM's, attendance will be restricted to 200 fans per team. Each school/team will receive 200 tickets that they can distribute as they see fit. A ticket will be required for admittance for anyone not on a school pass list. NO EXCEPTIONS. Masks and Social Distancing is required for all in attendance at all times. On Thursday the teams competing will receive 400 tickets per team. Those tickets will be distributed to the winning teams on Tuesday night.

Scorer's Table:

Syracuse High School will provide a PA announcer, scoreboard operator, and official bookkeeper. All score table workers must wear masks.

Locker Rooms: Each team will be provided a locker room, however, you are encouraged to come dressed and ready since 2 teams will need to share a locker room on the first day.

Team Benches:

The home team's bench area will be on the East side of the score table.

The visiting team's bench area will be on the West side of the score table.
