Parking: Team busses- drop players off on the South side of the school, please park your bus at the North end of the parking lot just west of the High school football field. Fan parking- South of the main entrance and to the East of the school.

Admission: We are at 50% capacity and allowing up to 75 students attend: \$5 Adults, \$4 Students (K-12). One entrance will be open for admission, this is the South entrance into the main lobby. Cheer squads are allowed.

A water bottle filling station is located near each gym, no water will be provided on team benches.

Visiting Fans: Please sit on the South side of the main gym and the North side in the auxiliary gym. No spectators may sit in the first row of the bleachers in the main gym.

Locker Rooms: Assigned upon arrival. Each team will be responsible for their own valuables. Teams will be given a key; please make sure you return it to a SHS school official before returning home.

Warm up: There will be twenty minutes for warm up prior to the game.

Trainer: Seward High will have an athletic trainer on duty.

National Anthem/Introduction: The National Anthem will be played followed by the starters for the guests then the home starter.
