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## Updated Winter COVID Protocols, 2020

Please share the following protocols with all pertinent persons.

Admission: Varsity contest in the main gym will allow fans to attend the game not to exceed 50% occupancy. Students from the visiting school shall not exceed 75 students in attendance. **IV/Reserve/Freshmen games competing in the auxiliary gym will be limited to family members only.**

### Protocols:

#### Teams:

- Visiting teams should prescreen all athletes prior to departure.
- Temp checks will occur during weigh-ins for wrestling events.
- Visiting schools are asked to travel with essential personnel only.
- Masks are required to be worn over the mouth and nose by non-participants, this includes coaches. Masks are optional while participating in the contest.
- Team members should not enter the stands to visit/interact with spectators.

#### Spectators:

- Family only for contests in the auxiliary gym. Attendance at varsity events in the main gym all allowed up to 50% capacity.
- Masks are required to be worn over the mouth and nose, family units must sit together, and social distancing between family units is required.
- Visiting BB fans will sit on same side as the score table in each gymnasium and use the visiting restroom which is located in the middle lobby just outside the auxiliary gym. Wrestling fans will have assigned areas in the bleachers for seating.
- Spectators are encouraged to remain only for their son/daughter's competition. No loitering following contests, fans should exit promptly.
- Spectators are asked to stay off the gym floor/mat and leave immediately following the contest (visiting administration is requested to assist).
- No outside food is allowed or team meals without prior approval.
- No pep band at this time.
