

**BOARD OF EDUCATION

A public hearing of the Board of Education of Fairbury Public Schools was convened in open and public session on March 9, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., in the '47 Building Conference Room, 703 K Street, Fairbury, Nebraska.

President Schwab read the public meeting notice published March 4, 2020, in the Fairbury Journal-News and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the publicized notice and a current copy of the Agenda was maintained as stated in the publicized notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.
