

**BOARD OF EDUCATION

A meeting of the Board of Education of Fairbury Public Schools was convened in open and public session on March 8, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., in the '47 Building Conference Room, 703 K Street, Fairbury, Nebraska. The roll was called and the following Board members were present or absent:

President Schwab read the public meeting notice published March 3, 2021, in the Fairbury Journal-News and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the publicized notice and a current copy of the Agenda was maintained as stated in the publicized notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. It was stated that the Board of Education makes available at least one copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the meeting room at a location accessible to members of the public. The Act is posted on the north wall of the meeting room. Visitors and guests were acknowledged.

Moved by Starr, seconded by Winter, to approve the consent agenda as follows: agenda; approval of minutes of February 8, 2021 Regular Meeting; approval of treasurer's report, claims, and monthly payroll; the resignations of Sami Oakes at the end of the 2020-2021 school year, Brendan Blackburn and Derek Anderson at the end of the 2020-2021 contract.

After discussion and on roll call vote; the board voted as follows:

Administrators and student board member submitted written and oral reports.

Moved by Milius, seconded by Starr, to hire Erik Ausk as general education teacher at CHANCE, Amy Schramm as TBD SPED teacher and Tate Harvey as elementary .5 PE/.5 Gen Ed teacher for the 2021-2022 school year.

After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

The motion carried.

Moved by Starr, seconded by Judd, to set May 21, 2021 as the last day (noon dismissal) for students and May 25 as last day for staff as presented for the 2020-2021 school year  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

The motion carried.

Moved by Winter, seconded by Starr, to approve using depreciation funds for the purchase of a 2020 Ford Transit (10 passenger) van from C&O Ford for \$39,800 and a 2021 Chevrolet (12 passenger) van from Riverside Chevrolet for \$30,716 as presented.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

Moved by Milius, seconded by Starr, to authorize the Superintendent to sell 2 school vans as presented.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

The motion carried.

Moved by Winter, seconded by Ebke, approving the appointment of Sean Molloy as the Jr/Sr High School Principal beginning with the 2021-22 school year and with the salary of \$102,000.00 as presented.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:

The motion carried.

Moved by Milius, seconded by Starr, approve the classified staff increase for the 2021-22 school year with a projected total cost increase of 3.86% as presented.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:  
Voting for: Judd, Milius, Schwab Starr, Winter, Ebke  
The motion carried.

Moved by Starr, seconded by Judd, approve the Administrative increases for the 2021-22 school year with a projected total cost increase of 2.82% as presented.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the board voted as follows:  
Voting for: Milius, Schwab Starr, Ebke, Judd  
Voting against: Winter  
The motion carried.

Moved by Winter, seconded by Starr, to approve setting March 24 7:30 pm - Board Work Session, '47 Building Conference Room, 703 K Street, Fairbury, NE. Purpose to discuss resource officer and other secondary options.  
After discussion and on roll call vote, the Board voted as follows:  
Voting for: Schwab, Starr, Winter, Ebke, Judd, Milius  
The motion carried.

Moved by Winter, seconded by Starr, to approve setting April 12, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. for the regular board meeting in the 47' Building Conference Room.

After discussion and on roll call vote, the Board voted as follows:

Voting for: Starr, Winter, Ebke, Milius, Schwab

The motion carried.
